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Proclamations of the Creator of the Universe

In the beginning, Elohim, who is Yahuweh the Father and Yahushua Yahuweh the Son, echad and inseparable, created the heavens and the earth – without Whom nothing was created!

Unto the One Eternal, self-existing, the life and the breath;

in the office of Creator;

by reason of the supreme authority of His Name;

by the character and credibility founded upon the infallibility of His Word, and by His faithfulness to perform all things which He has promised;

whereby has secured the legal power, and the exclusive rights of ownership of the entirety of the realm of His rule—His uniquely identifiable and fingerprinted creation;

have I due cause, in which bearing in my flesh, the fingerprint of my Creator, as one made in His likeness and image;

in all humility, and bowing the heart low because He has lifted my head high;

Yes...for this due cause, and reason I now cry out:

COME, and dwell with us: Establish Your Kingdom in righteousness as Judge

COME, and dwell among us: Gather Your family, and reconcile us to You in complete restoration through the intercessory work of our High Priest and Deliverer

COME, and dwell with us: Destroy those who destroy Your creation! Take up Your kingdom's reign and rule over us forever as King of Kings, and over all which You have created

For all of Your creation groans for the manifestation of the sons of Elohim, and we, the sons of Elohim, are groaning—awaiting for the manifestation of our Savior, Bridegroom and King—Yahushua the Messiah!

Proclamations of His Ownership

Proclaim His right to rule over all of creation

“And to Him was given rulership and preciousness and a reign, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His rule is an everlasting rule which shall not pass away, and His reign that which shall not be destroyed.” –Daniel 7:14

“And He said to me, “Son of man, this is the place of My throne and the place of the soles of My feet, when I dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever, and the house of Israel shall no longer defile My set-apart Name...” –Ezekiel 43:7a

“We give You thanks O Yahuweh, Elohim Shaddai, who is, who was, and who is to come, because You have taken Your great power, and have reigned.” –Revelation 11:15, 17

“And I saw another messenger flying in mid-heaven, holding the everlasting Good News to announce to those dwelling on the earth, even to every nation and tribe and tongue and people, saying with a loud voice, “Fear Elohim and give esteem to Him, because the hour of His judgment has come. And worship Him who made the heaven and the earth, and sea, and fountains of water.” –Revelation 14:6-7

“Praise Yah! Praise Yahuweh from the heavens, Praise Him in the heights! Praise Him, all His messengers; Praise Him, all His hosts! Praise Him, sun and moon; Praise Him, all you stars of light! Praise Him, heavens of heavens, and you waters above the heavens! Let them praise the Name of Yahuweh, for He commanded and they were created.” –Psalm 148:1-5

“Bless Yahuweh, O my being! O Yahuweh my Elohim, You have been very great: You have put on excellency and splendor, covering Yourself with light as with a garment, stretching out the heavens like a curtain...

The esteem of Yahuweh is forever, Yahuweh rejoices in His works, Who looks on the earth, and it trembles; He touches the mountains, and they smoke.

I sing to Yahuweh as long as I live, I sing praise to my Elohim while I exist. My meditation on Him is sweet; I rejoice in Yahuweh.

Let sinners be consumed from the earth, And let the wrong be no more. Bless Yahuweh, O my being! Praise Yah!” –Psalm 104:1-2, 31-35

“...And they do not cease, day or night, saying, “Set-apart, set-apart, set-apart, Yahuweh El Shaddai, who was, and who is, and who is coming!

You are worthy, O Yahuweh, to receive esteem and respect and power, for You have created all, and because of Your desire they are, and were created.” –excerpts from Revelation 4:8-10

“Because in Him were created all that are in the heavens and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or rulerships or principalities or authorities – all have been created through Him and for Him. And He is before all, and in Him all hold together.” –Colossians 1:16-17

“And I looked, and I heard the voice of many messengers around the throne, and the living creatures, and the elders. And the number of them was myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice, “Worthy is the Lamb having been slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and respect and esteem and blessing!”

And every creature which is in the heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying, “To Him sitting on the throne, and to the Lamb, be the blessing and the respect and the esteem and the might, forever and ever!” –Revelation 5:11-13

“The earth belongs to Yahuweh, and all that fills it – The world and those who dwell in it.” –Psalm 24:1

“And now, if you diligently obey My voice, and shall guard My covenant, then you shall be My treasured possession above all the peoples – **for all the earth is Mine**” –Exodus 19:5

Psalm 103:19 declares: “Yahuweh has established His throne in the heavens, and His reign shall rule over all.”

“The heaven is My throne, and earth is My footstool. What house shall you build for Me? Says Yahuweh, or what is the place of My rest? ‘Has My hand not made all these?’ –Acts 7:49-50

“And each in his own order: Messiah the first-fruits, then those who are of Messiah at His coming, then the end, when He delivers up the reign to Elohim the Father, when He has brought to naught all rule and all authority and power. For He has to reign until He has put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy to be brought to naught is death.” –1 Corinthians 15:23-26

O Yahuweh, Your Word states in Psalm 50:10-12: “For every beast of the forest is Mine, The cattle on a thousand hills. I know all the birds of the mountains, and all moving in My field are Mine. If I were hungry, I would not speak to you; for the world is Mine, and all that fills it.”

“Did you not know? Have you not heard? The everlasting Elohim, Yahuweh, the Creator of the ends of the earth, neither

faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable.” –Isaiah 40:28

And thou, O Yahuweh, shalt reign and rule, thou alone over all thy works on Mount Zion, the dwelling place of thy esteem, and in Jerusalem, thy set-apart city, as it is written in thy set-apart words, Yahuweh shall reign for ever, thy Elohim, O Zion, shall be King unto all generations. Praise ye Yahuweh.

Set-apart art thou, and dreaded is thy Name, and there is no Elohim beside thee, as it is written, and Yahuweh of hosts is exalted in judgment, and the set-apart Elohim is sanctified in righteousness. Blessed art thou, O Yahuweh, the set-apart King.

Thou hast chosen us from all peoples, thou hast loved us and taken pleasure in us, and hast exalted us above all tongues; thou hast sanctified us by thy commandments, and brought us near unto thy service, O our King, and hast called us by thy great and set-apart Name. –adopted from the High Holiday Prayer Book for Yom Teruah and Yom Kippur

“Yahuweh shall reign, He shall put on excellency; Yahuweh shall put on strength; He shall gird Himself. Indeed, the world is established, immovable. Your throne is established from of old; You are from everlasting.” –Psalm 93:1-2

Proclamations of His Infallibility as Savior

Proclaim that salvation is found in no other Name

O Yahuweh, the world has rejected your Son, the Savior of all mankind. They have trusted in their own ways through

technology, in searching for eternal life outside of your precious provision through the sacrifice of Your only Son, Who is the infallible embodiment of Your Word, and the only means for achieving everlasting life.

To all the earth, and those living in it...let it be known today that You, Yahuweh, are the Great and Almighty Deliverer Who brings salvation to Your people, and besides You, there is no Savior.

“But now, thus said Yahuweh, your Creator, O Ya’aqob, and He who formed you, O Israel, “Do not fear, for I have redeemed you. I have called you by your name, you are Mine.

When you pass through the waters, I am with you; and through rivers, they do not overflow you. When you walk through fire, you are not scorched, and a flame does not burn you.

For I am Yahuweh your Elohim, the Set-apart One of Israel, your Savior; I gave Mitsrayim for your ransom, Kush and Seba in your place.

Since you were precious in My eyes, you have been esteemed, and I have loved you. And I give men in your place, and peoples for your life. Do not fear, for I am with you. I shall bring your seed from the east, and gather you from the west.

I shall say to the north, ‘Give them up!’ And to the south, ‘Do not keep them back!’ Bring My sons from afar, and My daughters from the ends of the earth – all those who are called by My Name, whom I have created, formed, even made for My esteem.

He shall bring out a blind people who have eyes, and deaf ones who have ears. All the nations shall be assembled, and the peoples be gathered. Who among them declares this, and show us former events? Let them give their witnesses, to be declared right; or let them hear and say, “It is truth.”

You are My witnesses,” declares Yahuweh, “And My servant whom I have chosen, so that you know and believe Me, and understand that I am He. Before Me there was no El formed, nor after Me there is none.

I, I am Yahuweh, and besides Me there is no savior.

I, I have declared and saved, and made known, and there was no foreign mighty one among you. And you are My witnesses, declares Yahuweh, “that I am El.”

Even from the day I am He, and no one delivers out of My hand. I work, and who turns it back?” –Isaiah 43:1-13

“And there is no mighty one besides Me, a righteous El and a Savior, there is none besides Me. Turn to Me and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I am El, and there is none else.

I have sworn by Myself, a word has gone out of My mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, so that to Me every knee shall bow, every tongue swear.

One shall say, ‘Only in Yahuweh do I have righteousness and strength’ – he comes to Him. And all those displeased with Him

shall be put to shame. In Yahuweh all the seed of Israel shall be declared right and boast.” –Isaiah 45:21b-25

“And it shall be that everyone who calls on the Name of Yahuweh shall be delivered...” –Joel 2:32a; Acts 2:21; Romans 10:13

Messiah Yahushua said, “I come in My Father’s Name.” He came in the Name of Yahu – “I am the ever living, ever-existent One who breathes” The “shua” comes from yesha, which means salvation in its fullest terms. Only human beings have been extended the right to become sons of Elohim.

“Let it be known to all, and the people of Israel, that in the Name of Yahushua Messiah of Nazareth, whom you nailed to the stake, who Elohim rose from the dead, this one stands before you healed...and there is salvation in no other Name, for there is no other Name under heaven, given among men, by which you might be saved.” –Based on Acts 3

O Yahuweh, open thou my lips, that my mouth shall declare thy praise. O King, Helper, Savior and Shield...

Thou, O Yahuweh, art mighty for ever, thou quickens the dead, thou art mighty in salvation. Thou sustains the living with loving-kindness, quickens the dead with great mercy, supports the falling, heals the sick, looses the bound, and keeps thy faith to them that sleep in the dust.

Who is like unto thee, Yahuweh of mighty acts, and who resembles thee, O King, who kills and quickens, and causes salvation to spring forth?

Thou art set-apart, and thy Name is set-apart, and set-apart beings praise thee daily. –adopted from the High Holiday Prayer Book for Yom Teruah and Yom Kippur

Proclamations of His Position as King

Proclaim every knee shall bow to Him

“For it has been written, “As I live, says Yahuweh, every knee shall bow to Me, and every tongue shall confess to Elohim.” Each one of us, therefore, shall give account of himself to Elohim.” – Romans 14:11-12

“For, let this mind be in you which was also in Messiah Yahushua, who, being in the form of Elohim, did not regard equality with Elohim a matter to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant, and came to be in the likeness of men.

And having been found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death, death even of a stake. Elohim, therefore, has highly exalted Him and given Him the Name which is above every name, that at the Name of Yahushua every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and every tongue should confess that Yahushua Messiah is Master, to the esteem of Elohim the Father.” –Philippians 2:5-11

“O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before Yahuweh our maker.” –Psalm 95:6

“Yea, all kings shall fall down before him: all nations shall serve him.” –Psalm 72:11

“Let all nations You have made Come and bow themselves before You, O Yahuweh, And give esteem to Your Name.” –Psalm 86:9

“Why do the nations rage, and the peoples meditate emptiness? The sovereigns of the earth take their stand, And the rulers take counsel together, against Yahuweh and against His Messiah, and say, “Let us tear apart Their bonds, And throw away Their ropes from us.”

He who is sitting in the heavens laughs, Yahuweh mocks at them. Then He speaks to them in His wrath, and troubles them in His rage, saying, “But I, I have set My Sovereign on Tsiyon, My set-apart mountain. I inscribe for a law: Yahuweh has said to Me, ‘You are My Son, today I have brought You forth. Ask of Me, and I make the nations Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth Your possession.

Break them with a rod of iron, dash them to pieces like a potter’s vessel. And now, be wise, O sovereigns; be instructed, you rulers of the earth. Serve Yahuweh with fear, and rejoice with trembling. Kiss the Son, lest He be enraged, and you perish in the way, for soon His wrath is to be kindled. Blessed are all those taking refuge in Him.” –Psalm 2

Now, therefore, O Yahuweh our Elohim, impose thine dread upon all thy works, and thy dread upon all that thou hast created, that all works may fear thee and all creatures (mankind) prostrate (bow down) themselves before thee, that they may all form a single fellowship to do thy will with a perfect heart, even as we know, O Yahuweh our Elohim, that dominion is thine, strength is in thy hand, and might in thy right hand, and that thy Name is to be feared above all that thou hast created. –adopted from the High Holiday Prayer Book for Yom Teruah and Yom Kippur

Proclamations of His Authority to Judge

Proclaim the end of all enemies who oppose the Creator of the universe and His right to rule His creation

Messiah Yahushua said, “Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me possesses everlasting life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.

Truly, truly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of Elohim. And those having heard shall live.

For as the Father possesses life in Himself, so He gave also to the Son to possess life in Himself, and He has given Him authority also to do judgment, because He is the Son of Adam.

Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the tombs shall hear His voice, and shall come forth – those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have practiced evil matters, to a resurrection of judgment.

Of Myself I am unable to do any matter. As I hear, I judge, and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own desire, but the desire of the Father who sent Me.” –John 5:24-30

“And Yahushua came up and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.” –Matthew 28:18

“The foundation of Your throne is righteousness and justice” –
Based on Psalm 97:2

Only Yahushua has the power to forgive sins and to execute judgment on them. He has earned the right of authority as Judge of the universe through His obedience and by His ultimate act of sacrifice for the sins of the world!

“Looking to the Princely Leader and Perfecter of our belief, Yahushua, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the stake, having despised the shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of Elohim.” –Hebrews 12:2

“In that day a fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Yerushalayim, for sin and for uncleanness. And it shall be in that day, declares Yahuweh of hosts, that I cut off the names of the idols from the earth, and they shall be remembered no more, and I shall also remove the prophets and the unclean spirit from the earth.” –Zechariah 13:1-2

2 Timothy 4:1 states, “Yahushua will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and reign”

Yahuweh declares in Exodus 20:3-6, “You have no other mighty ones against My face. You do not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of that which is in the heavens above, or which is in the earth beneath, or which is in the waters under the earth, you do not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, Yahuweh your Elohim am a jealous El, visiting the crookedness of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing kindness to thousands, to those who love Me and guard My commands.”

It is written thus in Psalm 135:13-21, “O Yahuweh, Your Name is forever, O Yahuweh, Your remembrance to all generations, for Yahuweh rightly rules His people, and has compassion on His servants.

The idols of the nations are silver and gold, the work of men’s hands. They have mouths, but they do not speak; they have eyes, but they do not see; they have ears, but they do not hear; also there is no breath in their mouth. Those making them become like them, everyone who is trusting in them.

Bless Yahuweh, O house of Israel! Bless Yahuweh, O house of Aharon! Bless Yahuweh, O house of Levi! You who fear Yahuweh, bless Yahuweh!

Blessed from Tsiyon (Zion), Yahuweh be, Who dwells in Yerushalayim! Praise Yah.”

It is written in Habakkuk 2:18-20, “Of what use shall a carved image be? For its maker has carved it: a molded image and teacher

of falsehood! For the maker trusts what he has made: to make dumb idols!

Woe to him who says to wood, ‘Awake!’ to silent stone, ‘Arise!’ Is it a teacher? See, it is overlaid with gold and silver, and there is no spirit at all inside it.

But Yahuweh is in His set-apart temple. Let all the earth be silent before Him.”

All pride will be crushed and stamped out as it is written in Isaiah 2:12, 17-21:

“For Yahuweh of hosts has a day against all that is proud and lofty, against all that is lifted up, so that it is brought low;

And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the pride of men shall be brought low. And Yahuweh alone shall be exalted in that day, and the idols completely pass away.

And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, from dread of Yahuweh and the splendor of His excellency, when He arises to shake the earth mightily.

In that day man shall throw away his idols of silver and his idols of gold, which they made, each for himself to worship, to the moles and bats, to go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the crags of the rugged rocks, because of the fear of Yahuweh and the splendor of His excellency, when He arises to shake the earth mightily.”

“And then the lawless one shall be revealed, whom the Master shall consume with the Spirit of His mouth and bring to naught with the manifestation of His coming.” –2 Thessalonians 2:8

As a servant in right standing with the Judge of all creation, I proclaim:

Then shall the righteous and just also see and be glad, and the upright shall exult, and the virtuous triumphantly rejoice, while iniquity shall close her mouth, and all wickedness shall be wholly consumed like smoke, vanishing away, when thou removes the dominion of arrogance and tyranny; causing it to pass away from the earth. –adopted from the High Holiday Prayer Book for Yom Teruah and Yom Kippur

Proclamations of Land Ownership and Inheritance

Proclaim what He has promised and has chosen

Galatians 3:29 states, “And if you are of Messiah, then you are seed of Abraham, and heirs according to promise.”

O Yahuweh, all that You have promised shall come to pass—and very quickly!

You once spoke to Your servant and friend Abraham saying, “Go yourself out of your land, from your relatives and from your father’s house, to a land which I show you. And I shall make you a great nation, and bless you and make your name great, and you shall be a blessing!

And I shall bless those who bless you, and curse him who curses you. And in you all the clans of the earth shall be blessed. To your seed I give this land.” –Genesis 12:1-3; 7

“And He brought him outside and said, “Look now toward the heavens, and count the stars if you are able to count them.” And He said to him, “So are your seed.” And he believed in Yahuweh, and He reckoned it to him for righteousness.” –Genesis 15:5-6

“Even so Abraham did believe Elohim, and it was reckoned unto him as righteousness.” –Galatians 3:6

Remember, O Yahuweh, all that You have promised to Abraham, and to His descendants. Do not forget Your people, and the Land which You gave to our fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Come and rescue us, and plant us in Your garden—never again to be uprooted.

Remember Your servant and prophet Ezekiel, and all things which You have spoken through him regarding the inheritance of Your people and the possession of Your city:

“This is the land which you divide by lot as an inheritance among the tribes of Israel, and these are their portions,” declares the Master Yahuweh.

And these are the exits of the city, the gates of the city according to the names of the tribes of Israel: On the north side, measuring four thousand five hundred cubits, the three gates northward: one gate for Reuben, one gate for Yehudah, one gate for Levi.

And on the east side, four thousand five hundred cubits, three gates: one gate for Yoseph, one gate for Binyamin, one gate for Dan.

And on the south side, measuring four thousand five hundred cubits, three gates: one gate for Shimon, one gate for Yissakar, one gate for Zebulun.

And on the west side, four thousand five hundred cubits with their three gates: one gate for Gad, one gate for Asher, one gate for Naphtali.

All around: eighteen thousand cubits. And the name of the city from that day is: **Yahuweh is there!**” –Ezekiel 48:29-35

Remember Your servant and prophet Isaiah when You spoke through Him the promise of restoration and everlasting peace saying:

“And many peoples shall come and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of Yahuweh, to the House of the Elohim of Ya’aqob, and let Him teach us His ways, and let us walk in His paths, for out of Tsiyon comes forth the Torah, and the Word of Yahuweh from Yerushalayim.

And He shall judge between the nations, and shall reprove many peoples. And they shall beat their swords into ploughshares, and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither teach battle any more. O house of Ya’aqob, come and let us walk in the light of Yahuweh.” –Isaiah 2:3-5

O Yahuweh, we proclaim that East Jerusalem belongs to You and is the place You have chosen for Your dwelling and place of rest

“For Yahuweh has chosen Tsiyon, He has desired it for His dwelling: This is My place of rest forever; here I dwell, for I have desired it.” –Psalm 132:13-14

“And to his son I give one tribe, so that My servant David shall always have a lamp before Me in Yerushalayim, the city which I have chosen for Myself, to put My Name there.” –1 Kings 11:36

“The earth is Yahushua’s inheritance given by Yahuweh His Father” –Based on Psalm 2

Declaration for the Return of Messiah Yahushua

We declare that you, Yahushua, son of David, are King over all Israel. We believe that you are the Son of Elohim, the One who is chosen and anointed by YHWH as King and therefore we acknowledge you as our head and no other.

We believe that Your Kingdom and government is a true representation of YHWH's throne in heaven and you are coming in person to set up this government on earth: A real government with real power and authority and with a real army, for you are YHWH Tzeva’ot [Lord of Armies].

We declare that Yerushalayim is the location of your throne and not only our capital city but the joy of the whole earth. We long for the promise of your appearing and for you to judge the corrupt governments and religious systems of the earth.

We long for you to reveal your strong arm in the sight of all the nations, that they may know that your name is YHWH and that you alone are Elohim. Do not delay your coming! Oh that You would rend the heavens! That You would come down!...To make Your name known to Your adversaries, That the nations may tremble at Your presence (Isa 64).

Baruch Haba, Yahushua, bashem YHWH. Blessed are you, Yahushua, who comes in the name of YHWH. Only you can bring lasting peace for you are the Sar Shalom (Prince of Peace) and only you are worthy to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honour and glory and blessing!” –excerpt from “The Jerusalem Letter” by James Block (used with permission)

Proclamations of Redemption and the Establishment of His Kingdom Rule

O Yahuweh, remember Your promises to King David—the restoration of his Kingdom, and the order of worship he established around the tabernacle.

For You have spoken thus:

“In that day I shall raise up the booth of David which has fallen down. And I shall repair its breaches and raise up its ruins. And I shall build it as in the days of old, so that they possess the remnant of Edom, and all the nations on whom My Name is called, declares Yahuweh who does this.

Look, the days are coming, declares Yahuweh, that the ploughman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him who sows seed. And the mountains shall drip new wine, and all the hills melt.

And I shall turn back the captivity of My people Israel. And they shall build the waste cities and inhabit them. And they shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them, and shall make gardens and eat their fruit.

And I shall plant them on their own soil, and not uproot them any more from their own soil I have given them, said Yahuweh your Elohim!” –Amos 9:11-15

“And for the Beast who will rise above all to sit in the place of Your throne on the earth, and speak words against the Most High, to wear out the set-apart ones of the Most High, intending to change Your appointed times and law—they will be given into the hand of the Beast for a time and times and half a time...

But the Judgment shall sit, and they (the set-apart ones) shall take away its rule, to cut off and to destroy, until the end.

And the reign, and the rulership, and the greatness of the reigns under all the heavens, shall be given to the people, the set-apart ones of the Most High.

His reign is an everlasting reign, and all rulerships shall serve and obey Him.” –Based on Daniel 7:25-27

“Therefore the Master declares, Yahuweh of hosts, the Elohim of Israel, Ah, I shall be eased of My adversaries, and I shall be avenged of My enemies. And I shall turn My hand against you, and shall refine your dross as with lye, and shall remove all your alloy.

And I shall give back your judges as at the first, and your counselors as at the beginning. After this you shall be called the city of righteousness, a steadfast city.

Tsiyon shall be redeemed with right-ruling, and her returning ones with righteousness. And the destruction of transgressors and of sinners is together, and those who forsake Yahuweh shall be consumed.” –Isaiah 1:24-28

“O Yahuweh, remember us, Your chosen people whom You have called out of darkness and into Your marvelous light. We are a royal priesthood, a peculiar people, Your treasured possession above all of the peoples of the earth! Remember us! Come and save us!” –Based on 1 Kepha (Peter) 2:9; Exodus 19:5-6; Deuteronomy 7:6

“Arise, O Yahuweh! O El, lift up Your hand! Do not forget the lowly ones. Yahuweh is Sovereign forever and ever; the nations shall perish from His land. Yahuweh You have heard the desire of the lowly ones; You prepare their heart; You incline Your ear, to defend the fatherless and the downtrodden; so that man who is of the earth no longer oppresses!” –Based on Psalm 10:12, 16-18

“Arise Yahuweh - deliver your set-apart ones (poor, needy, oppressed, afflicted) Elohim arises, His enemies are scattered. And

those who hate Him flee before Him! As smoke is driven away, You drive them away; As wax melts before the fire, the wrong perish before Elohim.

But the righteous are glad, they exult before Elohim. And they rejoice with gladness. Sing to Elohim, sing praises to His Name. Raise up a highway for Him Who rides through the deserts, by His Name Yah, and exult before Him.

Elohim makes a home for the lonely; He brings out into prosperity those who are bound with chains; Only the rebellious shall dwell in a dry land. O Elohim, when You went out before Your people, when You stepped through the wilderness, Selah. The earth shook and the heavens dropped before Elohim, this Sinai, shook before Elohim, the Elohim of Israel” –Based on Psalm 68:1-4, 6-8

“For the needy is not always forgotten; Neither the expectancy of the poor lost forever. Arise, O Yahuweh, do not let man prevail; let the nations be judged before Your face.” –Psalm 9:18-19

“Arise, and let Your enemies be scattered. Protect the poor and needy, shelter the helpless, strengthen the weary, rise to the defense of your humble ones, contrite ones, those who tremble at Your Word, who depend on You 100% for everything. Your Word says in Matthew 5:3, Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the Kingdom of heaven. Listen, my beloved brothers: Has Elohim not chosen the poor of this world, rich in belief and heirs of the reign which He promised to those who love Him?”—Based

on James 2:1-13; Amos 8; Psalm 9:18-19, 12:1-8, 68:1-6; Psalm 102:13-22; Psalm 132:12-13; Numbers 10:34-35

“Save, Yahuweh, for the kind one is no more! For the trustworthy have ceased from among the sons of men. They speak falsehood with each other; they speak with flattering lips, a double heart. Yahuweh does cut off all flattering lips, a tongue that speaks swelling words, who have said, With our tongue we do mightily; our lips are our own; who is master over us?

Because of the oppression of the poor, because of the sighing of the needy, I now arise,” says Yahuweh, I set in safety – he pants for it. The Words of Yahuweh are clean Words, Silver tried in a furnace of earth, refined seven times. You guard them, O Yahuweh, You preserve them from this generation forever. The wrong walk around on every side, when worthlessness is exalted among the sons of men.” –Psalm 12:1-8

O Yahuweh, come and liberate Your city and Your people from those who possess the spirit of destruction. We proclaim the liberation and redemption of Jerusalem:

“For Zion’s sake I am not silent, and for Jerusalem’s sake I do not rest, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her deliverance as a lamp that burns.

And the nations shall see your righteousness, and all sovereigns your esteem. And you shall be called by a new name, which the mouth of Yahuweh designates. And you shall be a crown of comeliness in the hand of Yahuweh, and a royal head-dress in the

hand of your Elohim. No longer are you called “Forsaken,” and no longer is your land called “Deserted.” But you shall be called “Hephtsibah,” and your land “Married,” for Yahuweh shall delight in you, and your land be married.

For as a young man marries a maiden, so shall your sons marry you. And as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your Elohim rejoice over you. I have set watchmen on your walls, O Yerushalayim, all the day and all the night, continually, who are not silent

You who remember Yahuweh, give yourselves no rest, and give Him no rest till He establishes and till He makes Yerushalayim a praise in the earth.

See, Yahuweh has proclaimed to the end of the earth: Say to the daughter of Tsiyon, see, your deliverance has come; see, His reward is with Him, and His work before Him.

And they shall be called, the Set-Apart People, the Redeemed of Yahuweh. And you shall be called, Sought Out, a City Not Forsaken.” –Isaiah 62:1-7, 11-12

We proclaim that the enemy cannot usurp or override the will of Yahuweh, no matter what he and his agents attempt! Yahuweh is in absolute control. We proclaim His right as Creator to take over His creation and rule it!

We cry out for the protection of the remnant of Yehudah (Judah) in Jerusalem who will come to faith in Messiah, and those who will be alive at His coming.

“And I shall pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Yerushalayim a spirit of favor and prayers. And they shall look on Me whom they pierced, and they shall mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son.

In that day a fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Yerushalayim, for sin and for uncleanness.”—
Zechariah 12:10; 13:1

We cry out for the peace of Yahuweh, whose heart is broken, that in His wrath He will remember those who love Him and have remained loyal to Him – He will have His family! We proclaim our loyalty to Him as our Abba Father!

“And He saw that there was no man, and was astonished that there was no intercessor. So His own arm saved for Him, and His righteousness upheld him. And He put on righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of deliverance on His head.

And He put on garments of vengeance for clothing, and wrapped Himself with ardor as a mantle. According to their deeds, so He repays, wrath to His adversaries, recompense to His enemies. He repays recompense to the coastlands.

And they shall fear the Name of Yahuweh from the west, and His esteem from the rising of the sun, when He comes like a distressing stream which the Spirit of Yahuweh drives on.

And the Redeemer shall come to Tsiyon, and to those turning from transgression in Ya'aqob, declares Yahuweh.

As for Me, this is My covenant with them,” said Yahuweh: My Spirit that is upon you, and My Words that I have put in your mouth, shall not be withdrawn from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants descendants, said Yahuweh, from this time and forever.” –Isaiah 59:16-21

“Arise, shine, for your light has come! And the esteem of Yahuweh has risen upon you. For look, darkness covers the earth, and thick darkness the peoples. But Yahuweh arises over you, and His esteem is seen upon you. “And the nations shall come to your light, and sovereigns to the brightness of your rising.” –Isaiah 60:1-3

“Who is this coming from Edom, with garments of glowing colors from Botsrah, who is robed in splendor, striding forward in the greatness of His strength? It is I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save. Why is there red on Your raiment, and Your garments like one who treads in the winepress?

I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples no one was with Me. And I trod them down in My displeasure, and I

trampled them in My wrath. Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have defiled all My raiment.

For a day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come. And I looked, but there was none helping, and I was astonished that there was none upholding. So My own arm saved for Me, and My wrath upheld Me. And I trod down peoples in My displeasure, and made them drunk in My wrath, and brought down their strength to earth.” –Isaiah 63:1-6

“See, on the mountains the feet of him who brings good news, who proclaims peace! O Yehudah, observe your festivals, perform your vows. For Beliya’al shall no more pass through you. He has been cut off completely.” –Nahum 1:15

“Of the increase of His rule and peace there is no end, upon the throne of David and over His reign, to establish it and sustain it with right-ruling and with righteousness from now on, even forever. The ardor of Yahuweh of hosts does this.” –Isaiah 9:7

“He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Most High. And Yahuweh Elohim shall give Him the throne of His father David. And He shall reign over the house of Ya’aqob forever, and there shall be no end to His reign.” –Luke 1:33

“This, then, is the way you should pray: Our Father who is in the heavens, let Your Name be set-apart, let Your kingdom come, let Your desire be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

And do not lead us into trial, but deliver us from the wicked.”—
Based on Matthew 6:9-13

Proclamations for the Fulfillment of Ezekiel 48:35 and the Restoration of All Things

O Yahuweh, we join in with all of Your creation in the intensive longing to be delivered from the bondage of corruption, and for our soon coming Redemption and change:

“For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the esteem that is to be revealed in us.

For the intense longing of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of Elohim. For the creation was subjected to futility, not from choice, but because of Him who subjected it, in anticipation, that the creation itself also shall be delivered from the bondage to corruption into the esteemed freedom of the children of Elohim.

For we know that all the creation groans together, and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now. And not only so, but even we ourselves who have the first-fruits of the Spirit, we ourselves also groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.” –Romans 8:18-23

“Oh that my words were now written! oh that they were printed in a book! That they were graven with an iron pen and lead in the rock for ever! For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:

And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God: Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; though my reins be consumed within me.” –Job 19:23-27

“Yahushua—You are the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in You, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in You shall never die. This, I Believe! Yea, Master: I believe that thou art the Messiah, the Son of Elohim, which should come into the world.”—Based on John 11:25-27

“O Yahuweh, remember Your people who fear You, and who speak to one another, and You shall listen and hear us: for You said a book of remembrance would be written before You, of those who fear You, and those who think upon Your Name.

And You said that we shall be Yours on the day that You prepare a treasured possession. And You shall spare us as a man spares his own son who serves him.

Then we shall again see the difference between the righteous and the wrong, between one who serves You and one who does not serve You.” –Based upon Malachi 3:16-18

“Arise to Your rest O Yahuweh! Take relief from Your sorrow and grief!” –Based on Psalm 132:8, 13-14

Come, O Mighty One of Israel, King of our delight—come and dwell among Your people whom thou has saved!

“We raise a shout for Yahuweh, in all the earth! We serve Yahuweh with gladness; We come before Your presence with singing.

We know that You, Yahuweh, You are Elohim; You have made us, and we are Yours – Your people and the sheep of Your pasture.

We enter into Your gates with thanksgiving, and into Your courts with praise. We give thanks to You; bless Your Name. For You, Yahuweh, are good; Your kindness is everlasting, And Your truth is to all generations.” –Based on Psalm 100

O Yahuweh, from the beginning You have desired a people, a family to dwell among. You have sent Your Son Yahushua—Immanuel—as proof of Your love towards us. For it is only by Your Son that You, Elohim, are with us. You have commanded of Your people to be set-apart as You are set-apart—only then can You--will You dwell among Your people.

O Father, we have embraced Your commandments—they are as honey—a delight unto us. Your Word brings us life and we are alive today because we have chosen to cling to You, the author of life. –Based on Deuteronomy 4:4

Come and restore us! Come and renew us and Your creation which You have made, and have called into existence out of nothing. Come, Creator, Abba Father, You and the Ark of Your strength! Come and dwell among us and we shall take joy in becoming Your treasured possession.

“And I shall set My Dwelling Place in your midst, and My being shall not reject you. And I shall walk in your midst, and shall be your Elohim, and you shall be My people.” –Leviticus 26:11-12

“And I saw a renewed heaven and a renewed earth, for the former heaven and the former earth had passed away, and the sea is no more. And I, John, saw the set-apart city, renewed Yerushalayim, coming down out of the heaven from Elohim, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

And I heard a loud voice from the heaven saying, **“See, the Booth of Elohim is with men, and He shall dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and Elohim Himself shall be with them and be their Elohim.**

And Elohim shall wipe away every tear from their eyes, and there shall be no more death, nor mourning, nor crying. And there shall be no more pain, for the former matters have passed away.” – Revelation 21:1-4

“Give thanks to Yahuweh, call upon His Name, make known His deeds among the peoples! Sing to Him, sing praise to Him, speak of all His wonders! Boast in His set-apart Name, let the hearts of those seeking Yahuweh rejoice!

Seek Yahuweh and His strength, seek His face continually! Remember His wonders which He has done, His signs and the right-rulings of His mouth, O seed of Israel, His servant; O children of Ya’aqob, His chosen ones!

He is Yahuweh our Elohim, His right-rulings are in all the earth. Remember His covenant forever, the Word He commanded for a thousand generations, which He made with Abraham, and His oath to Yitzak, and He established it to Ya'aqob for a law, to Israel as an everlasting covenant,

Saying, to you I give the land of Kana'an, the portion of your inheritance, when you were but few in number, few indeed, and sojourners in it. And they went up and down, from one nation to another, and from one reign to another people.

He allowed no one to oppress them, and He reprov'd sovereigns for their sakes, saying: Do not touch My anointed ones, and do My prophets no evil.

Sing to Yahuweh, all the earth; proclaim His deliverance from day to day. Declare His esteem among the nations, His wonders among all peoples. For great is Yahuweh and greatly to be praised; and He is to be feared above all mighty ones. For all the mighty ones of the peoples are matters of naught, But Yahuweh made the heavens.

Excellency and splendor are before Him, strength and gladness are in His place. Ascribe to Yahuweh, O clans of the peoples, ascribe to Yahuweh esteem and strength.

Ascribe to Yahuweh the esteem of His Name; bring an offering, and come before Him; bow yourself to Yahuweh in the splendor of set-apartness!

Tremble before Him, all the earth. The world also is firmly established, immovable. Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; and let them say among the nations, Yahuweh shall reign.

Let the sea roar, and all that fills it; let the field rejoice, and all that is in it. Let the trees of the forest then sing before Yahuweh, for He shall come to judge the earth.

Give thanks to Yahuweh, for He is good, for His kindness is everlasting! And say, Save us, O Elohim of our deliverance; and gather us together, and deliver us from the nations, to give thanks to Your set-apart Name, and boast in Your praise.

Blessed be Yahuweh Elohim of Israel from everlasting to everlasting! And all the people said, "Amein!" and praised Yahuweh." –1 Chronicles 16:8-36

Remember, O Yahuweh, Your promises and plans which You have spoken and established for those that love You.

"For we have no continuing city, but we seek the one coming!" – Hebrews 13:14

For in all these things, we take joy in the blessed hope of our resurrection--made possible through Your Son's resurrection and victory over death. For soon, we will join You--never again to be separated. For You, our Elohim, will dwell among us, and we, your people, ARE THERE WITH YOU!
